## COMMUNITY

Jiggi Catchment Landcare Group (JCLG) was formed in 1992. The groups first project was to restore the Jiggi School grounds and adjacent riparian zone. The project aimed to convert an ex horse paddock & seriously degraded stream bank into a healthy ecosystem able to be used as an outdoor classroom. The site is now a source of pride & home to two threatened species.

Many volunteer community hours have been dedicated to working with school pupils in the years since the groups formation, to enhance the conservation values of the school grounds.

The group works closely with the local community, aiming to increase their skills and knowledge regarding all aspects of natural area restoration. Well attended and informative workshops and field days are held annually.







## **FUNDING**

The landcare group has been very successful with accessing funding to undertake major environmental projects. Consequently most of the group's work is now taking place on members' properties.

JCLG members who demonstrate commitment to restoring the ecological values of their land are now able to be assisted by professional bush regenerators to help them achieve their goals.
